42 yr old resident of Chhota Udikel village in
Karra block of Khunti District in Jharkhand

His willingness to continuously improve and openness towards learning innovations in farming led him to reach **NSK.**



Punam Kumari, a NSK fellow educated **Nanka** about various govt. schemes including Aam Bagwani (Mango Orchard) program, an initiative under Birsa Harit Gram Yojana.

Recognising the opportunity to **create a stable income source** inspired Nanka to participate



From April to June, NSK fellow Punam guided Nanka from registration to approval of his application from Gram Sabha and by August end he received mango plants for his orchard.

Nanka's initiative extended, he introduced **intercropping**, growing vegetables alongside mango trees.



This strategy not only increased land utility but also **enhances food security** and **economic prospects for Nanka** alongside continuing to the **greening and enrichment of local landscape**
